Recipe Corner

Beef Enchilada Pie

by Janet Froh (from the IDOS Convention Recipes 2002-2004 book)

16 regular-size flour tortillas
3 lb extra-lean ground beef
1/2 onion, finely chopped
1 small can chopped green chiles
3 15 oz. cans of tomato sauce
3 2 1/4 oz cans of sliced olives, drained
24 oz. of Sargento grated 4-cheese
Mexican blend cheese
1/3 pkg taco seasoning mix
1 30 oz. can mild enchilada sauce

14" DO, 12-15 servings1.5 hrs to bake12 coals on bottom and 16 coals on top

1. Brown the ground beef with the onion and taco seasoning. Drain the excess fat.

2. Add the green chiles, olives, tomato sauce and 16 oz. of the cheese. Stir until the cheese melts.

3.Lightly grease the DO and arrange four tortillas on the bottom of the oven.

4. Scoop 1/3 of the meat mixture and spread over the tortillas. Repeat this process two more times and arrange the last four tortillas over the last layer of meat mixture.

5. Pour the entire can of enchilada sauce on top of the shells and sprinkle the remaining 8 oz. of cheese over the enchilada sauce.

6. Cover and bake for 1.5 hrs.

Eat and enjoy.
